how bad he is hurt.

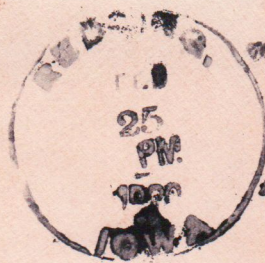
My dear I don't know
