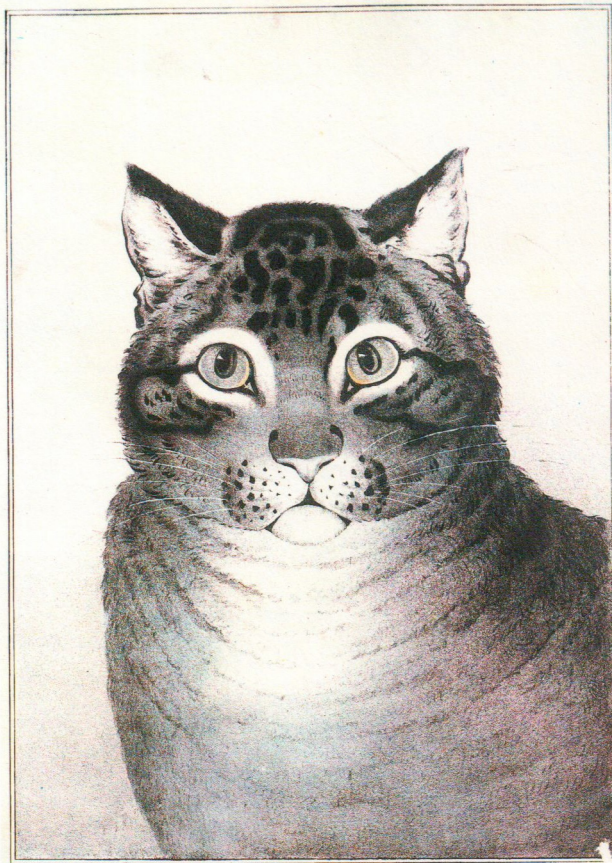




THE FAVORITE CAT.
