Fourteen readings below zero recorded in January

Coldest temperature recorded during the month of January was 18 degrees below zero, according to Mrs Della Korn, local weather observer. Next lowest was 15 degrees below zero on the 27th.

There were a total of 14 readings below zero. The high temperature was 55 degrees on January 8th.

Precipitation for the month was 0.27 of an inch with a total of 6 inches of snow falling, all received after January 11th. Normal for the first month of the year is 0.97.

The average temperature during the day was 22 degrees and during the night 6 degrees.

In January of 1962, the high temperature was 44 degrees on January 25. The low was 15 below on January 15 with 10 readings of below zero, all between January 8 and January 23rd.

10.5 inches of snow was received with a moisture content of 1.41 inches.

There were 16 inches of snow on the ground on January 1, 1962, and ended with 7 inches on the ground.
